The Women's Club at UIUC and the Spurlock Museum Guild are again organizing an exciting trip to the Field Museum for two outstanding exhibits with time for shopping!

1. *Jacqueline Kennedy: The White House Years*

More than 70 garments worn by one of the 20th century's great fashion icons, plus photographs, documents and film clips. (Tour of exhibit scheduled for 9:30 AM.)

2. *Machu Picchu: Unveiling the Mystery*

A look back at the very Scientific Expedition to this Inca site. Includes replicas, spectacular panoramic photographs, and some fine examples of Inca art. (Tour of exhibit scheduled for 11:30 AM.) Plus, some time for shopping.

Cost: \$42 per person (includes both exhibits). In order to keep the cost down, we will only be providing bottled water on the bus. You are welcome to bring your own snacks.

Departure: November 17 at 7:00 AM. We will leave from the E-14 parking lot (across from the Assembly Hall). Place a note on dashboard saying "SPURLOCK MUSEUM".

Lunch is on your own. A Bread Company and MacDonald's are located in the Field Museum.

We plan to depart Chicago at 3:00 PM and arrive in C-U about 6:00 PM.


